


Economics for Health Cigarette Tax Scorecard

Bosnia and Herzegovina Fact Sheet


Cigarette tax policies in 2024

The Scorecard assessed four key tax components using a 5-point scale, namely cigarette price, change in cigarette affordability, tax share and tax structure, with the overall score reflecting an average of Bosnia and Herzegovina's component scores. The score reflects the current strengths and opportunities in Bosnia and Herzegovina to further increase tax revenue and improve health.



Cigarette tax policies over time

Bosnia and Herzegovina's overall score declined between 2014 and 2022. In 2024, the score remained the same as in 2022. The country has not been able to reduce cigarette affordability since 2022.



Comparing Bosnia and Herzegovina to other countries

Bosnia and Herzegovina scores higher than the average score of countries in its income group and the global average, but further improvements are needed to reach the regional average and top performing countries.
